



Configuring disabled accessible turn escutcheon

If mounting a disabled accessible turn, the escutcheon will need to be configured according to the mortice lock in use.

- Refer to the images below to identify the mortice lock in use.
- Remove the screws according to the turn setting required. 2. Selector configurations should allow 45° rotation, Synergy configurations should rotate to 90°. Use images below as a guide.











2 Door preparation

- 1. Cut out the template from the bottom of the sheet.
- Remove lock from mortice and place the template in the correct 2. alignment according the the required backset.
- Mark hole centres accurately and drill holes required. 3.
- For through fixing, cut screws to length. Deburr end of cut screws. 4. Note: Do not cut screws with pliers or side cutters as this is likely to cause thread damage upon assembly.



3 Mounting instructions

Use the appropriate tailbar according to escutcheon combination being installed. Follow instructions below for mounting each type of turn combination.



1. Insert spring and narrow end

of tailbar into turnknob or

Suits 32-45mm doors

- 2. Pass tailbar completely through the turn snib adapter as shown.
- 3. Make sure tailbar engages with the turn
- disabled accessible turn until engaged and retained. escutcheon on the other side of the lock.
